

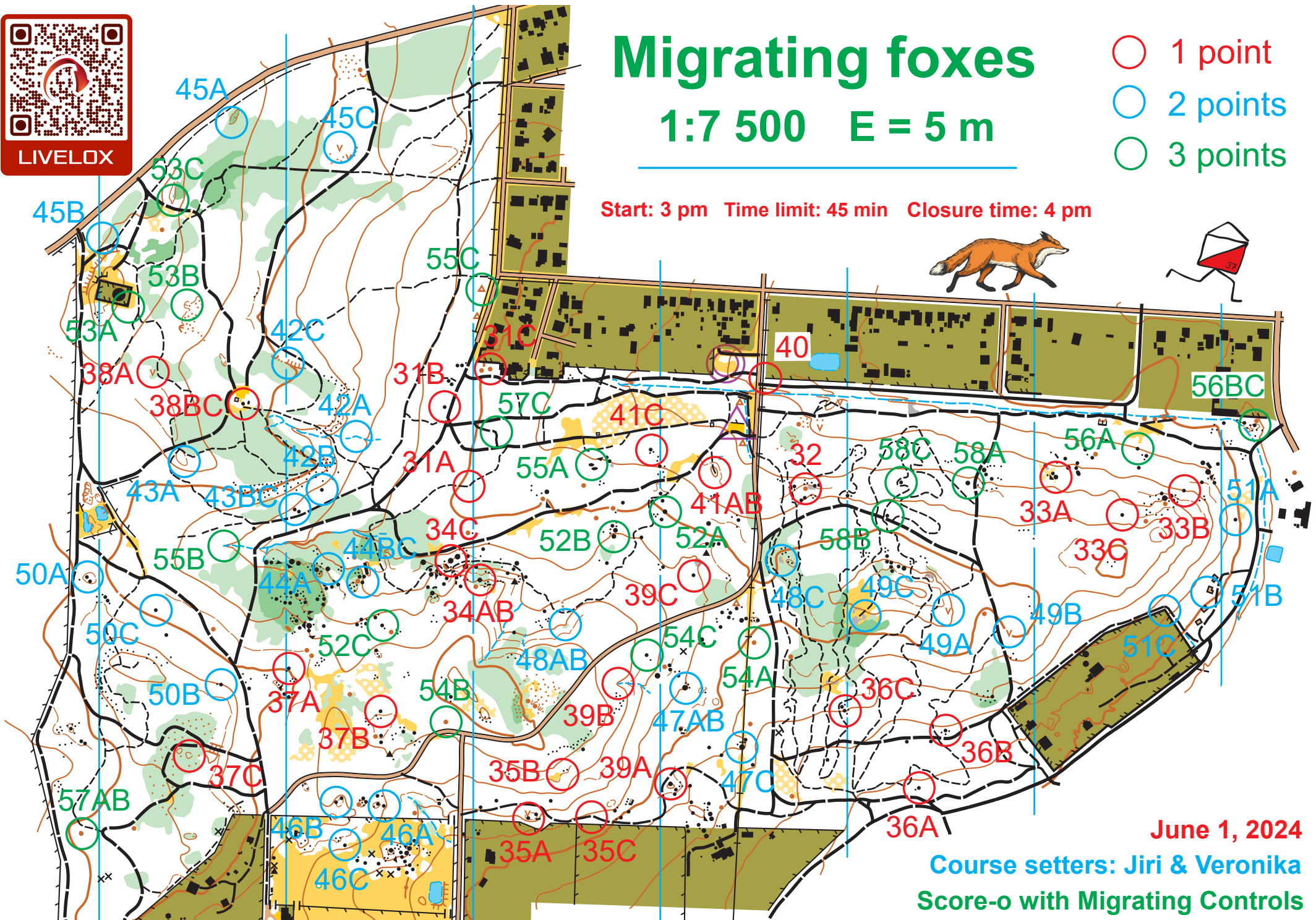

RULES:

- Time limit = 45 minutes**
- Start - mass start at 3pm.** The map is given to each runner five minutes before he/she starts to study the route.
- Points** - controls have the value of different number of points, marked in map:
- red drawn ... 1-point
- blue drawn ... 2-point
- green drawn ... 3-point
Maximum of points is 52.
- Punching** - electronic punching system SI. Punching is possible only in the control point and in the "open time" given by the time table. In the course of migration is the punching not allowed. In that time the controls bite, scratch, strangle and are punch-resistant.
If SI unit is missing in correct open time, punch control into map. (Jiri or Veronika is in trouble)

5. Penalty

- if the finish time of the competitor exceeds the time limit.
 45 min < finish time < 46 min ... 1 point is subtracted
 46 min <= finish time < 47 min ... 1+2=3 points are subtracted
 47 min <= finish time < 48 min ... 1+2+3=6 points are subtracted
 48 min <= finish time < 49 min ... 1+2+3+4=10 points are subtracted

6. Timetable and description

at assembly area you may pick up sheet of paper with control timetable and description

Eg. of time table for control num. 37: time [min]; points: control description

7. Results

The points for each control are counted up only once time. That means eg. that control 36A, 36B, 36C is the only one control for scoring points. So is it in fact. It doesn't make any sense to punch the control of the same number in different control points.

The resulting sequence of runners is given by the points they get. If two or more competitors score equal number of points, the shorter finish time is defining.
